The PPE program trains students to consider the political, philosophical and economic components of key contemporary issues. We seek candidates with demonstrated teaching experience, preferably in a liberal arts and multicultural settings.

We invite applicants from any area of competence (AOC) and specialization (AOS) in PPE, although preference will be given to those who can teach courses **in quantitative and qualitative research methodologies in political science** and contribute to the development of PPE as an interdisciplinary and international program. We seek enthusiastic candidates with experience supervising and advising undergraduate students, and who can demonstrate a commitment to curriculum or program development.

The successful candidate will I be hired at the Professor/Associate/Assistant/Lecturer level, depending on experience and research record. The usual teaching load is six courses per academic year.
